What is DIPG/DMG?

Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG) and Diffuse Midline Glioma (DMG) are devastating forms of brain cancer that primarily affects children. These tumours, located in the brainstem, are inoperable and resistant to treatment, with a survival rate of less than 1%. DIPG/DMG robs children of their ability to walk, talk, eat, and eventually breathe, while families are left with little hope and even fewer treatment options. The urgent need for research and funding to combat these diseases cannot be overstated.

Who is RUN DIPG?

RUN DIPG is an Australian-based not-for-profit organisation founded by Dr Phoebe Hindley and Professor Matt Dun after their daughter, Josie, was diagnosed with DIPG in February 2018. Sadly, Josie passed away 22-months post diagnosis: - FOREVER 4. Since our inception in 2019, RUN DIPG has worked tirelessly to fund innovative research, raise awareness, and provide support to families impacted by this cruel disease. To date, we have contributed over \$3.8 million in DIPG/DMG research, creating a platform for hope and change in a space that desperately needs it.

What do we do?

RUN DIPG organises community events, fundraisers, and educational campaigns to raise vital funds and awareness for DIPG/DMG. Our signature events are RUN 4 RUN DIPG, Moonlight Gala, Heels to Heal Lunch in Newcastle and Sydney. We help families and their friends create fundraisers in their local communities such as The Ox in Lennox Head, Ahlia's Kindness Day, Hundred 4 Harper just to name a few. Our largest educational campaign is Memories in May which sees the faces of innocent Australian children diagnosed with DIPG/DMG featuring on prominent billboards nationwide.
